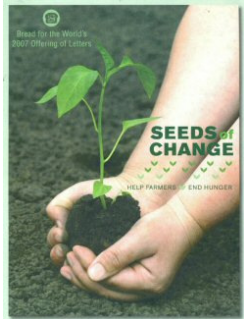

Bread for the World: "Farm Bill"

Adult Seminar, Wednesday, June 6

Lake Shore's participation in the Bread for the World *Offering of Letters* will focus on the U.S. farm bill this year. The farm bill began in the 1930s as a response to the Great Depression and the Dust Bowl

and is now a staple of U.S. domestic agriculture and economic policy. It currently includes provisions for local farmers, food stamps, and public school nutrition programs and gets updated every five years. With much-needed improvements, changes to the bill can provide better support for U.S. farmers; strengthen U.S. rural communities; help hungry people in the U.S. afford a sufficient, nutritious diet; and help small farmers in developing countries sell their crops so they, too, can feed their families.

Seth Wispelsey, BFW organizer for Texas and Oklahoma, will lead our seminar. Wednesday, June 6. We will learn more about the farm bill and its implications, as well as write letters to our legislators in Washington. Last year Lake Shore sent an incredible 103 letters to Senators Cornyn and Hutchison and Representative Edwards, and we would love to top that number in 2007. This year our goal is to send in 115 letters so please come join us as we work to plant seeds for change! — *Kelly Baker*
